The Department of Health is offering scholarships of up to \$13,000 for university level qualifications to lived and living experience workers (LLEW) employed in state-funded mental health or alcohol and other drug services.

The scholarships aim to support LLEW, from early stage and aspiring leaders, through to experienced and senior leaders, to confidently take on diverse leadership roles across the system.

The Collective administers the scholarships on behalf of the Department of Health. The Collective supports LLEW through training, discipline-specific practice and access to supervision.
